PLEASE BE ASSURED THAT ADVANCED WASTE SERVICES, INC. IS FULLY COMPLIANT WITH THE EXPECTATIONS AND INTENT OF THE ***TRANSPORTATION WORKERS IDENTIFICATION CREDENTIAL (TWIC) CARD.***

What this means to you, is that all of our workers who require unescorted access to secure areas of maritime facilities and vessels and all U.S. credentialed mariners, have registered and are equipped a TWIC card. Although we have established our compliance well before the national deadline of April 15, 2009, it is anticipated that more than 1 million workers including longshoremen, truckers, port employees and others will be required to obtain a TWIC. This vital security control program requires you to ensure that your affected vendors are meeting the same obligation as AWS.

Additionally, and since September 25<sup>th</sup> 2003, the U.S. D.O.T. has required all transporters of hazardous materials to have a written plan in place that evaluates their transportation process, personnel, and facilities/equipment with a security focus. This letter was additionally designed to remind you that AWS has always met these requirements, and that our evaluation and written plan are on file at the corporate office in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
