Injury & Illness Prevention:

AWS diligently investigates all incidents involving injury and property damage until root causes and preventative measures have been identified. We accept that over 9 out of 10 incidents occur due to human error, and have identified human error as the root cause of nearly all of our incidents. To that end, we monitor hours of service, fatigue and the perceived need to rush through tasks very closely in order to reduce our exposure to human error.

Driver Qualifications:

- **Advanced Waste Services currently has >80 Commercially Licensed Drivers**
- **All new company drivers are evaluated on the follow criteria:**
 - ✓ A minimum age of 21 with 3 years of road experience
 - ✓ Required to pass a company road test and physical exam
 - ✓ Number of Moving Violations permitted: Discretionary
 - ✓ Good CSA 2013 Standing
 - ✓ Number of reportable accidents: Discretionary
 - ✓ A previous employment history is taken from the past three years conducted via telephone, letter, and fax

- ✓ A thorough and routine review of Motor Vehicle Record
- ✓ A minimum education level of High school or an equivalency is required
- ✓ Vacuum Pump Operation is preferred
- ✓ All requisitions and subsequent hiring decisions are authorized by the following personnel:
 - Bill Christel – VP of ESH and HR

Driver Training:

All of our new drivers go through extensive training programs to ensure they work in a productive and professional manner.

- ✓ Training length is an estimated 2-3 weeks, with time spent in a partnership with an “Elite” company driver
- ✓ Our training programs include materials expressed via lecture, and personal discussion
- ✓ A record is kept of each driver training session
- ✓ Drivers receive an orientation guide and checklist
- ✓ All of our training is administered by company staff and driver/trainers
- ✓ Topics covered in our training sessions include:
 - Speeding Policy
 - Alcohol/Narcotics/Drug Abuse
 - Hazardous material regulations
 - Hazardous materials identification on shipping papers
 - Placarding
 - Emergency procedures
 - Rail/highway grade crossing procedures
 - Vehicle inspections
 - Driver logs
 - Loading/bracing/blocks
 - Customer site safety rules policy
 - Loading/unloading procedure
 - Equipment operation
 - Equipment inspections
 - Immediate emergency response measures

Driver Management:

- ✓ AWS communicates with all of its drivers and field employees via cell phone, GPS, and Ipad/tablet communications
- ✓ All trucks have a speed limit policy that is governed by each individual truck, with speed control systems enforced by an onboard computer
- ✓ AWS uses company surveillance to monitor driver performance
- ✓ All drivers are required to report traffic violations
 - When recording accidents, they are logged in a written, verbal, and quarterly review
- ✓ All complaints are reviewed with the driver and safety team
- ✓ No passengers are allowed to ride in the cabs of any vehicles
- ✓ Advanced Waste Services conducts regular driver performance reviews and maintains an ongoing safety program for all its drivers and employees
- ✓ All special/hazardous material permits are maintained by :
 - Paul Meahl – Reports and Permits Manager

Incident Communications:

- ✓ 24 hour emergency number: 1-800-842-9792, is located on all shipping forms and information
- ✓ A written accident report is required of all of our drivers, along with a written review by the current supervisor
- ✓ In the event of an accident, the driver is to call the local authorities
- ✓ All shippers are notified of any incidents

Emergency Response:

- ✓ All drivers have an Emergency Response Guide book (DOT P5800.2 or equivalent) in their vehicles
- ✓ All carriers are equipped with emergency response capabilities
- ✓ On a case by case basis, some carriers use outside services for emergency response
- ✓ All vehicles are equipped with recovery drums
- ✓ All response teams are activated by our central dispatch

Vehicle Inspections:

Advanced Waste Services is committed to keeping all of our trucks and facilities at an Elite status

- ✓ Vehicle inspections are performed pre and post trip with inspection follow ups from an AWS certified mechanic
- ✓ Shop inspections are performed every 90 days
- ✓ When performing a tractor inspection, the following is checked:
 - Steering linkage
 - Brakes
 - Engine belts/hoses
 - Fluid levels
 - Lights
 - Windshield glass
 - Tires
 - Couplings/air hose
 - Fifth wheel
- ✓ When performing a trailer inspection, the following is checked:
 - Undercarriage
 - Tires
 - Floor
 - Sidewalls
 - Brake adjustment
 - Lights
 - Doors

Equipment Maintenance:

- ✓ All Maintenance on vehicles is performed in one of two locations:
 - The Advanced Waste Services company shop: PM interval
 - An outside shop, which provides full service for our lease tractors
- ✓ Scheduled preventive maintenance is performed:
 - Every 90 days for tractors
 - Every 30 days for trailers

- ✓ Maintenance service is audited subject to FMCSA Safety Investigations

Cargo Tank Inspection and Testing:

- ✓ Visual Inspections, hydrostatic testing, and relief valve bench testing and inspection is performed at:
 - Our Advanced Waste Services company facility
 - Stuart Tank
 - Glen Denning
- ✓ The visual inspection interval for cargo tanks is 1 year
- ✓ The hydrostatic test interval for cargo tanks is 5 years, 2 years on rear open tanks
- ✓ Our pre trip inspections are performed visually
- ✓ Our post trip inspections are done following the DVIR
